Providence Children’s Museum (PCM) seeks two RI public elementary school educators to serve as curricular experts for our professional development program to assist with program facilitation and teacher support. PCM’s Play Intensive Program includes in-person/ virtual workshops for PreK to 4th grade to teach them the fundamentals of play-based learning. Teachers are then guided through the process of transforming popular museum activities into standards-aligned lesson plans. The lesson plans will be part of a library that inspires creativity, cultivates social-emotional skills, and engages learners through a play-based approach.

With a long history of success in engaging younger children in learning through a model that blends facilitation with discovery and play, and with a new interactive web site, PCM has a unique opportunity to provide parents and educators with engaging play based and standards-structured resources for young children.

Specifics:

The consultants will assist with the planning and facilitation of The Play Intensive, serve as content specialists for either STEAM or Humanities during the workshop and ensure that the activities and lesson plans created by teachers are aligned to standards and developmentally appropriate.

Time Period: October 2021- June 2022

October- December 2021: Work with PCM team on program planning and content development.

January – June 2022: Participate in educator trainings, review lesson plans for standards alignment, provide guidance to teachers.
